<b>What the role involves</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Attend training and support sessions to learn environmental management and behaviour change techniques in the workplace</li> <li>- Meet regularly with your assigned Green Impact team at the University of Melbourne</li> <li>- Support the team to implement sustainability actions and ensure timely submission of workbook</li> <li>- Communicate with Sustainable Campus on the progress of your assigned team</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Attend training to learn how to conduct an environmental audit</li> <li>- Audit at least one Green Impact team on the sustainability actions that they have implemented</li> </ul>
<b>Time commitment</b>	- ½ hour to 2 hours per week for 4 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 3 hour auditor training session</li> <li>- 1-2 hours per audit</li> </ul>
