## Eligibility

To be a Sustainability Volunteer you must:

- Complete and submit the Volunteer Registration Form to the Sustainability Team before commencing your shift.
- Attend the volunteer shifts that you sign up for by arriving on time and staying for the full duration.
- Communicate with the Sustainability Team at least 24 hours before a volunteer shift if you are unable to attend. We will be recording any no shows which will impact your chances of receiving another offer to volunteer.
- Complete the volunteer activity to the highest standard and with integrity.
- Conduct yourself in a professional and friendly manner.
- Bring along any materials that you are instructed to by the Sustainability Team.
